

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Event Details:

Wednesday 8th of January 2014 – Scrutineering & Practice:

Scrutineering is mandatory for all competitors with no exceptions. It will take place in the Speedway City pits, at the undercover carport and office located near the entry to the track between 10.00 am and 3.00 pm.

All racing equipment and safety apparel will need to be available for inspection.

Practice will start at 4.00 pm and conclude at 8.00 pm. All normal racing rules will apply for the practice sessions.

Thursday 9th January – Drivers Briefing and Calcutta:

This year's driver's briefing and Calcutta event will be held at White Line Transport, 7 Belfree Drive, Greenfields. Entry is gained via the side gate, with ample parking on the roadways.

The evening will start at 6.00pm with a compulsory drivers meeting in the upstairs balcony. The drivers briefing will be conducted as per rule 7.15 of the Speedcars rule book.

The Calcutta event will kick off at 6.30 pm with everybody welcome to join in the social activities. It's the once a year event to catch up with old friends and 'chew the fat' while enjoying food and drinks.

There will also be trade displays, vintage displays and memorabilia. Bar facilities will be available with drinks at bar prices with proceeds benefiting the 'Shine' charity which promotes awareness of mental illness.

Food will be served from the front of the venue by Texas Bull Catering. Select roasts will be available with sweets, fruit, tea and coffee. Entertainment will be by Mick Kidd; a local acoustic song writer and artist.

The cost will be \$40.00 per head which includes your entry, entertainment and meals. Tickets can be pre-booked by contacting the SA Speedcar Association via sasa@welovedirt.com or include the number of tickets on your nomination & an SA Speedcar rep will contact you directly!

No smoking is permitted inside the venue however a dedicated area will be outside and close by.

Calcutta Draw: Per the heat draws, seeding will be used to match 2 drivers to be auctioned as a team.

Heat Draw: Each driver will be seeded (1 to 10 etc based on current points randomly in a heat with allocations pre drawn prior to the event).

The first two rounds of heat grid positions will be drawn during the evening's proceedings per the supplementary Australia Championship rules in the current rule book.

Friday 10th of January 2014 - Qualifying Night:

Drivers meeting: 4.00 pm. Engine starts 4:30pm Hot Laps 5:00pm.

Each competitor will contest three heats on Friday. Points will be allocated as per the 12/13 Speedcars Australia rule book. After the first two heats a redraw will be conducted to determine the remaining heat grids (rounds three and four).

The top 20 point scorers will race a 20 lap preliminary feature. Points will be allocated for this event as per the current rule the continued tally into night two.

Saturday 11th of January 2014 - THE MAIN EVENT!

Drivers meeting: 4.00 pm. Engine starts 4:30pm Hot Laps 5:00pm.

Heats: Each competitor will contest their 4th and final qualifying heat.

B Main: For all non-qualifiers to the final (19th and above in overall points). The first two finishers will transfer to the A-Main. The 3rd, 4th and 5th finishers will be permitted to act as reserves in their respective order.

Pole Shuffle: Top 8 point scorers on overall points will qualify into the Pole Shuffle. Pole position for the A-Main will be decided with the best of three shuffles.

73rd Australian Speedcar Championship A-Main: Distance 40 laps. The top 18 in points qualify directly to the A-Main. 19th and 20th positions will be taken from the 1st and 2nd finishers in the B main.

Position 21 will be available to the defending champion should he fail to qualify in the 20 available positions, per the 12/13 rule book.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Conditions of Entry:

Competitors enter and drive at their own risk and must meet personal accident insurance obligations as per Speedway Australia requirements. All competitors and crews must sign appropriate indemnity forms before competing.

This event will be conducted under the rules and regulations stipulated by Speedcars Australia including the possibility of engine, fuel and weight testing throughout the event. Failure by any person/s including driver, owner and crew, to comply with these and all Speedcars Australia rules and regulations may result in the exclusion of the car/driver from this event. Nomination fee is \$400.00 per competitor and must accompany each nomination form. All Nominated Speedcar Drivers and three (3) crew members

will receive free entry into the speedway complex for the three events including official practice (8th, 10th & 11th). This excludes spare car nominations per previous title events. Pit bands for the 3 nights will be provided during scrutineering. Please do not remove once placed on your wrist.

Nominations close Friday 20th of December. A late nomination fee will apply after this date. Any nominations received after Monday 6th January 2014 at 5pm, will incur the late fee and the competitor will start ROF in their first two heats per section 7.7 of the 12/13 Speedcars Australia Rulebook. Spare car nomination fee is \$100 – details must be included in the nomination and undergo inspection.
